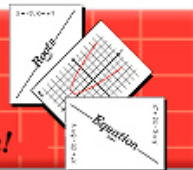

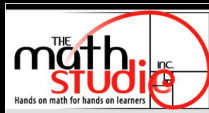

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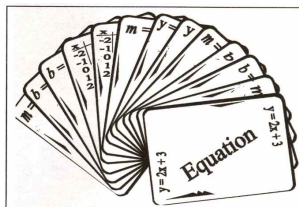
Greetings!

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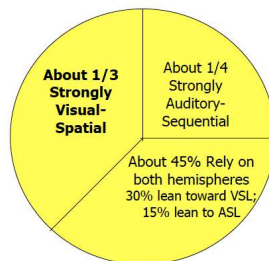
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Visual-Spatial Learners

When kids have low scores in math and high scores in other subjects

Visual-spatial learners generally think in pictures and diagrams and do better with mathematics taught in this traditionally verbal fashion. The term "visual-spatial learner" was created by Linda Silverman, PhD. Further research helped her understand that many of these children had some very interesting things in common such as:

- thinking primarily in pictures
- good at reading maps
- needing to visualize words in order to spell them
- using intuition to solve problems
- having uneven subject grades in school

- often highly perfectionistic
